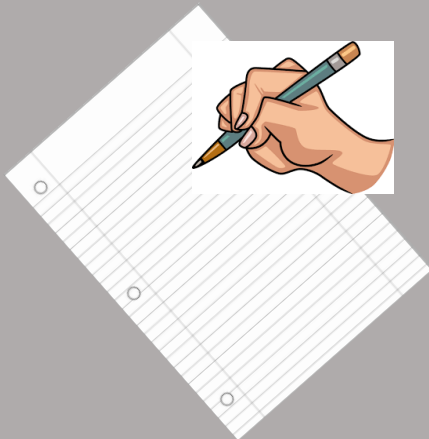

Bengal Students...According to the [National Center for Education Statistics](#), a study done on Extracurricular Participation And Student Engagement indicates that, "Extracurricular activities provide a channel for reinforcing the lessons learned in the classroom, offering students the opportunity to apply academic skills in a real-world context, and are thus considered part of a well-rounded education. Recent research suggests that participation in extracurricular activities may increase students' sense of engagement or attachment to their school, and thereby decrease the likelihood of school failure and dropping out (Lamborn et al, 1992; Finn, 1993)."

Choices 3, 4, & 5 will be entered as alternative courses & will be used if there is a conflict in scheduling.
