

New Online Re-enrollment for 2022-2023!

Helena schools have switched to an electronic form for student re-enrollment. This form will take the place of several forms that were sent home to be completed by all students each year, including updating all of your contact information so we can stay in touch and the medical forms that help us make sure we are meeting all students' health and safety needs. The form is located in the PowerSchool parent portal:

Step 1: Log in to the Portal

If you are unable to access the parent portal, please contact your school office and they will help you sign in. If you do not have internet access, please call the school and arrange a time when you can come in person to log in and complete the form.


Step 2: Open the Form


Click the link on the left for "Returning Student Registration (2020-2022)"

The form has several sections, which can be accessed by clicking on them, or you can move through the form using the "Next" button at the bottom of each page. The pages will save automatically when you click "Next," so if you lose your connection, you should not lose your work from any other pages. Simply log in again and continue the form.

Step 3: Submit the form

After you digitally "sign" the form, you will see a summary that shows any incomplete sections in red. Complete sections are shown with a zero and a green label Please click to return and complete these sections. When they are all complete, click "Submit" to send the form to your child's school. You will then have the option of downloading and printing the form if you wish to do so.

ATTENTION **SENIORS** AND **PARENTS** OF SENIORS

One of the many things to think about over the summer is senior pictures. While we encourage you to explore your options during the photo session, there are a few things to act on when it comes to submitting your yearbook photo. Please have your professional photographer submit your senior picture following these instructions:



- 1. Photos must be submitted in a digital format by email to mwalsh@helenaschools.org. The digital image must be no smaller than 4x6 inches and 300 dpi. They must be saved as lastnamefirstname. For example, Anna Smith would be Smithanna. Photos taken on a cell phone are NOT high enough resolution and will be denied for print.
- 2. Image must be good clarity and detail. Image should be made from the original digital image or negative. No special effects permitted.
- 3. All photos MUST be in color. No black and white or sepia photos will be accepted.
- 4. Scanned images from photographs may not be accepted due to loss of quality in the scanning process.
- 5. Photos must be a professional looking portrait from the waist up.
- 6. No props may be visible, i.e. cars, animal, flags or instruments. We would rather highlight you on the other pages in this manner.
- 7. Dress should be appropriate attire; standard school dress is suggested.


Senior Photos that do not adhere to these standards may be cut from the yearbook. The student's school photo will be substituted if the requirements are not met or if we do not receive a photo by the deadline.

Also, senior photos will not be returned to the students.

Homecoming week will be the week of September 12th. We encourage your child to get involved.



Dual Credit Opportunities

Parents- Students who are 16 or at least a junior are able to take dual credit courses. These courses are taught on the HHS Campus by our instructors, but with some additional paperwork, students can also earn college credit through Helena College. We will be working to remind students of this opportunity at the beginning of the school year, but we would like to make you aware of it as well. All parking permits will need to be purchased on-line and then picked up in the Main Of-

fice. All vehicles that students plan to drive/park in the HHS lot must be registered. To create an account, the user name is the initial of your first name and your full last name. The password is your student ID #. Once you are in, you create your own password to continue. If you bought one online last year, you just need to reuse the password you created. For cash or check purchases follow the same process up to the payment option; print your request and take it to the main office for permit availability. Payment on-line is the **ONLY** way to reserve a permit.

From the Desk of the School Nurse-Welcome Back!

I hope summer brought your family some relaxation! We are gearing up to open our doors at the end of August and looking forward to meeting and seeing your students! As your school nurse, I would like to share some information with you about school nursing.

Helena Public School Nurses serve in every school building with each nurse serving multiple schools/programs. Although our priority is the care of students coming into the health rooms, the school nurses' professional responsibilities cover a broad range of activities.

Parents may meet the school nurse at academic team meetings regarding their student's progress and challenges. Parents may receive calls from the school nurse to identify health and safety measures for their students. The nurses serve as chronic disease case managers, bridging the gap between parents, health care providers and staff.



You can easily submit your student(s) bus registrations through Parent Portal. You will receive immediate updates regarding the process of your bus registration.

LIVE NOTIFICATIONS


You will receive live GPS location of your child(s) school bus. The app will even notify your when the bus is approaching your stop or if the bus is experiencing weather delays.

BUS PASS

See real-time information about when your student(s) arrive to and from school by swiping their bus pass.

PARENT PORTAL OUR CENTRAL HUB

Parents – Edulog Parent Portal smartphone app is our central hub for all your transportation needs. By using our app you can easily register your student(s) for transportation, receive bus assignments and live-time communication. A few benefits of using our app involves the real-time location of your student(s) school bus and notifications when your bus will be arriving at your assigned stop.

Only you have access to your student's transportation information through the app via a secure login process. You must know your student's school of attendance, ID number and date of birth. Please be sure to enter the exact spelling of your student(s) first name and last

BUS REGISTRATIONS

Welcome to the future of Helena Public Schools - Transportation!

Bus registration is now open for the upcoming school year. To register your student(s) for transportation, you will need to download the Parent Portal app and submit a bus registration within this application.

Registering your children for school does not mean they are also registered nor eligible for school bus transportation. To find out if your child is eligible for transportation, please visit the Bus Stop page located on our website. If you are eligible, it may take 3 to 5 business days for transportation registration to take effect so please plan accordingly. Keep in mind that if you are eligible and register your children to ride the bus, you must register them each year. Failure to submit a new register each year means your child will not be assigned to a bus.


