### *Collaboration Works!*

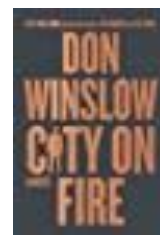
- ✓ After a collaborative conversation with Ms. Cloninger, we were able to create a graphic organizer with writing prompts that fit into her lesson plan.
