

### ATTENTION SENIORS AND PARENTS OF SENIORS

One of the many things to think about over the summer is **senior pictures**. While we encourage you to explore your options during the photo session, there are a few things to act on when it comes to submitting your yearbook photo:

Please have your professional photographer submit your senior picture following these instructions:

1. Photos must be submitted in a digital format by email to <u>mwalsh@helenaschools.org</u>. The digital image must be no smaller than 4x6 inches and 300 dpi. They must be saved as



lastnamefirstname. For example, Anna Smith would be Smithanna. Photos taken on a cell phone are **NOT** high enough resolution and will be denied for print.

2. Image must be good clarity and detail. Image should be made from the original digital image or negative. No special effects permitted.

3. All photos **MUST** be in color. No black and white or sepia photos will be accepted.

4. Scanned images from photographs may not be accepted due to loss of quality in the scanning process.

5. Photos must be a professional looking portrait from the waist up.

6. No props may be visible, i.e. cars, animal, flags or instruments. We would rather highlight you on the other pages in this manner.

7. Dress should be appropriate attire; standard school dress is suggested.

Photos that do not adhere to these standards may be cut from the yearbook. The stu-

dent's school photo will be substituted if the requirements are not met or if we do not receive a photo by the deadline. Also, senior photos will not be returned to the students.

The DEADLINE for submission is **OCTOBER 20, 2023.** Please keep this date in mind and make your appointments early. Photographers also need time to process your photos before they can be submitted. If you have any ques-

### **STUDENT LOCKERS**

Parents- Students who are 16 or at least a junior are able to take dual credit courses. These courses are taught on the HHS Campus by our instructors, but with some additional paperwork, students can also earn college credit through Helena College. ## **Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Opportunities**

AP courses offer students the opportunity to get a head start on college while in the supportive environment of a high school classroom. Students can earn college credit or placement by taking the AP exam at the end of the school year, while at the same time achieving a higher level of learning. These rigorous courses are offered on the Helena High campus.

If your student will be taking an AP course, and is interested in sitting for an AP exam, **registra-tion will open on Monday, September 11**<sup>th</sup> and will continue through November 1<sup>st</sup>. Students pay approximately \$100 to take these exams through College Board. Registration will take place through Revtrak starting on September 11<sup>th</sup>. Taking an AP exam is optional, but we strongly encourage students to consider the opportunity.

## **PARKING PERMITS**

All parking permits will need to be purchased on-line and then picked up in the Main Office. All vehicles that students plan to drive/park in the HHS lot must be registered. To cre-

ate an account, the user name is the initial of your first name and your full last name. The password is your student ID #. Once you are in, you create your own password to continue. If you bought one online last year, you just need to reuse the password you created. For cash or check purchases follow the same process up to the payment option; print your request and take it to the main office for permit availability. Payment on-line is the **ONLY** way to reserve a permit.



### AFFIDAVIT OF EXEMPTION ON RELI-GIOUS GROUNDS FROM MONTANA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION LAW AND RULES

In schools K-12, a claim of exemption from immunization requirements on religious grounds must be maintained on the Religious Exemption form. The form must be provided to the school prior to each school year by the student's parent/legal guardian, unless the student is 18 years of age or older or emancipated, the student may claim the exemption. The original copy of the religious exemption must be kept by the school as part of the student's school record. If a student has contracted a disease or is exposed to a disease, the student may be excluded from school by the local health officer or the state department until the excluding authority feels that there is no longer a risk of contracting or transmitting that disease.



You can easily submit your student(s) bus registrations through Parent Portal. You will receive immediate updates regarding the process of your bus registration.


### LIVE NOTIFICATIONS

### PARENT PORTAL OUR CENTRAL HUB

Parents – Edulog Parent Portal smartphone app is our central hub for all your transportation needs. By using our app you can easily register your student(s) for transportation, receive bus assignments and live-time communication. A few benefits of using our app involves the real-time location of your student(s) school bus and notifications when your bus will be arriving at your assigned stop.





## **BUS REGISTRATIONS**

Welcome to the future of Helena Public Schools - Transportation!

Bus registration is now open for the upcoming school year. To register your student(s) for transportation, you will need to download the Parent Portal app and submit a bus registration within this application.

Registering your children for school does not mean they are also registered nor eligible for school bus transportation. To find out if your child is eligible for transportation, please visit the <u>Bus Stop page</u> located on our website. If you are eligible, it may take 3 to 5 business days for transportation registration to take effect so please plan accordingly. Keep in mind that if you are eligible and register your children to ride the bus, you must register them each year. Failure to submit a new register each year means your child will not be assigned to a bus.



Only you have access to your student's transportation information through the app via a secure login process. You must know your student's school of attendance, ID number and date of birth. Please be sure to enter the exact spelling of your student(s) first name and last name.
