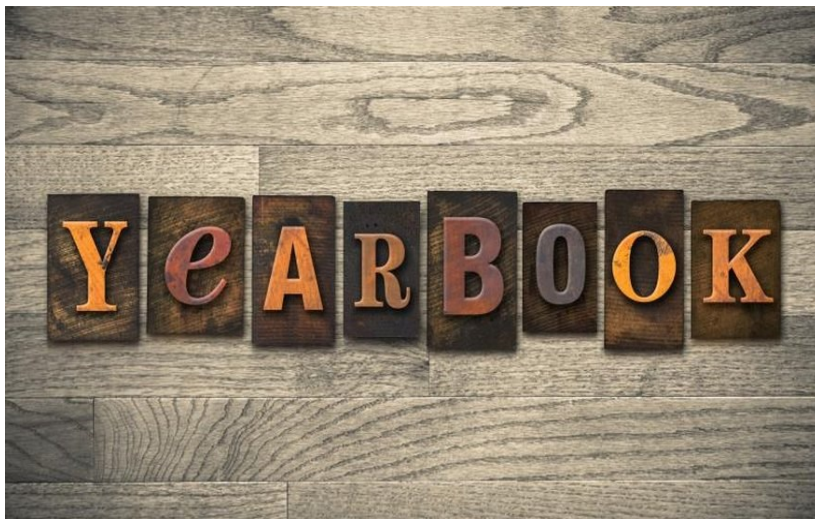
Attendance Information

If you are not getting a live person when you contact the Attendance Office - it is probably due to a high volume of emails, calls, and other notifications regarding our students. Please leave us a message about your student's absence (name, date, duration, person calling) or your request for their dismissal (name, dismissal date and time, person requesting dismissal). Because of the new app that several parents and students have on their phones, the app leaves us a very tight window for inputting all our student attendance information. Please do not be concerned if you have left a message but receive a notification on the app for your student. The only time you need to be concerned that we did NOT receive your message is if you get a voicemail/email notification regarding your student. This will take place, at the earliest, at 9:50 am.

Also, many times, parents will show up at the window requesting an immediate dismissal for their student. This is problematic depending on where your student is in the building (some are possibly in the shops or PE) and that makes it nearly impossible to get them out in a timely manner. The more notice we have for your student's dismissal, the better! We realize, of course, that there are times of last-minute appointments being scheduled and we'll be happy to work with you to get your student released. Thank you for your understanding!

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 20 2023

Please keep this date in mind and make your appointments early. Photographers also need time to process your photos before they can be submitted. If you have any questions, please contact Ms. Walsh at 324-2310 or at mwalsh@helenaschools.org.

PHOTO GUIDELINES:

1. The digital image must be a portrait frame (vertical), not a landscape frame (horizontal). Landscape images will be cropped by us.
2. Images should be no smaller than 4x6 inches and 300 dpi. **Preferred size is 5x7 at 300 dpi.** When in doubt, send us the original file. Photos taken on a cell phone are NOT high enough resolution and may be denied for print.
3. **All photos MUST be in color.** No black and white or sepia photos will be accepted.
4. **No props** may be visible, i.e. cars, animal, flags or instruments. We would rather highlight you on the other pages in this manner.
5. Dress should be appropriate attire; standard school dress is suggested.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

1. Photos must be **submitted in a digital format by email (mwalsh@helenaschools.org)**. Emailing images from your phone may compress the image, so please use a computer.
2. **Saved the image as LastnameFirstname.** For example, Anna Smith would be SmithAnna.

NOTICE:

Photos that do not adhere to these standards may be cut from the yearbook. The student's school photo will be substituted if the requirements are not met or if we do not receive a photo by the deadline.

If we do not receive a senior photo and the student did not have a school picture taken, they will not be included in the portrait section of the yearbook.

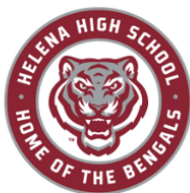
