#### Advanced Placement (AP)

- AP exams offer the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced course placement
- Students take the optional AP Exam in May
- If your student is enrolled in an AP course, you should have received an email on 9/6 with instructions on how to register/pay for an AP exam
  - AP teachers give students their AP join codes
  - Student creates or logs in to College Board AP account to join the course
  - Payment of \$100 per exam is made in Revtrak by Nov. 14th. (\$40 late registration or drop fee after Nov. 14th date)
- Exams take place between May 6-17th.
  - If there is a conflict with the exam date, contact AP Coordinator

#### **AP Course Transfer Credits**

Each college and university has its own policies regarding AP credit and placement. The College Board offers information about AP credit at thousands of schools and how a course and exam score will transfer.
