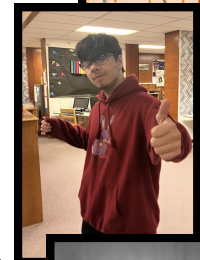

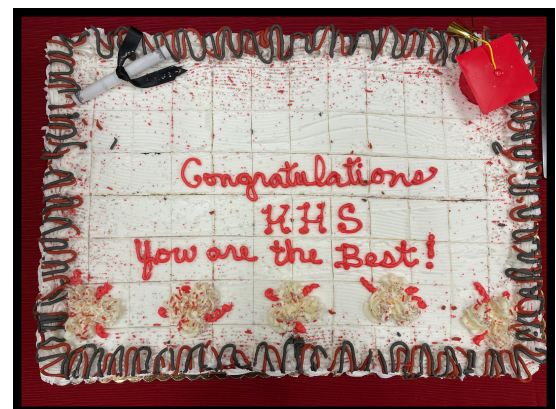

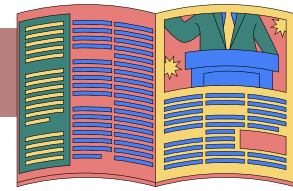

Did you know all employees and students at Helena High have access to over 200 online magazines? This magazine collection includes the most current issues and access to previous issues. Multiple staff and students can access the magazines at the same time and there is no checkout limit.

This collection includes subjects that match all curricular areas and interests, including, *Shop Notes Magazine, Woodworking, College Admissions, Photography Weekly, Pianist, Discover, Science Illustrated, Writer's Digest, National Geographic, National Geographic History, American History* and **MANY MORE.** There are also magazines in Spanish, French, and Chinese.
